ANNUAL REPORT 2016-17
4 Nov 2017

1. On behalf of the Committee, it is my pleasure to present the Annual Report of the Australian Army Aviation Association, Inc., for the year 2016-17.

OBJECTS OF THE ASSOCIATION

2. The Objects for which the Association was formed as laid out in the Rules remain unchanged and continue to guide the Committee in our management of the organisation. They are:
 - a. To work together to assist financially, culturally and socially the handicapped and/or disadvantaged and/or infirm of the serving and ex-Service Army Aviation personnel, including their immediate family members;
 - b. To make such representations and/or recommendations as may be appropriate to the Army, other associations and welfare agencies on behalf of any Member in difficulty or suffering hardship;
 - c. To make contributions from the funds of the Association, by way of gratuities, testimonials, or otherwise to any person, body, institution or organisation where, in the opinion of the Management Committee of the Association, such should be made for the promotion of these objects;
 - d. To promote the recording and display of Australian Army Aviation history;
 - e. To provide a forum for open discussion of all matters of interest to serving and ex-Service Army Aviation personnel;
 - f. To provide a means by which those who are serving or have served in Army Aviation units, and others who are associated with or interested in Army Aviation may keep in touch with each other and with Army Aviation affairs;
 - g. To foster understanding in the public arena of issues affecting serving and ex-Service Army Aviation personnel and their immediate families;
 - h. To pay out of funds of the Association all expenses of and incidental to the formation thereof, its management and carrying out of its objects, including the payment of salaries to persons employed by it; and
 - i. To foster the interests of Army Aviation.

ACTIVITY

3. 2016-17 saw the Army Aviation Association emerge from a period of low activity and a number of major decisions were taken by the management committee to prepare for the 50th Anniversary of the formation of the Australian Army Aviation Corps in 2018.

4. In March 2017, the Association organised and conducted a very successful Formal Dinner at Oakey to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the action by (then) Lieutenant Frank McNamara that led to the award of the Victoria Cross. This was the first time that an Australian airman had been awarded the VC for actions in the air. It came to the attention of the committee that the Frank McNamara club at Oakey did not have a portrait of their namesake. To rectify this, the Association commissioned a framed photo of McNamara VC that was presented to the President of the Club during the dinner by the Fourays President.
5. In a particularly generous gesture, one of our members, Ross Smith, OAM, a former RSM of the Corps, constructed a framed presentation of a photo of McNamara along with his ribbons, uniform accoutrements, and his VC citation and donated it to the Army Aviation Museum. Ross was unfortunately unable to attend the dinner and the presentation was made by the President on his behalf to the Commandant of the Army Aviation Training Centre for onforwarding to the Museum.

DIGITAL FOURAYS

6. As predicted in the 2015-16 Annual Report, a good deal of behind the scenes work has been done to revamp the Fourays website. Difficulties with the current hosting arrangements and some inherent inflexibility with the software have frustrated some of the work, however, a recent decision has been made by the committee to engage a developer to transfer the site to a new and more manageable hosting arrangement. The committee is currently in negotiation with Airbus Helicopters who have offered to sponsor the re-development.
7. Recently Fourays struggled into the 21st Century and established a presence on FaceBook. It is a modest effort at this stage, but with development should attract younger serving officers and soldiers into our fold. The FaceBook page will complement the revamped website providing more immediate information and previews of substantial articles and papers that will appear on the website.

MEMBERSHIP

8. There has been encouraging growth in the Association membership in FY 2016-17. While it is modest at just under 3%, it reverses a recent four year trend of flat or negative growth and is the best growth in membership since 2001.

9. It is to be hoped that the inclusion of FaceBook in our digital footprint will attract younger membership.
10. During the past year we have seen the passing two members of the Association, one a former member of the management committee. In April 2017 LTCOL Henk Pronk passed away following a long battle with cancer. A former Commanding Officer of the 1st Aviation Regiment he was long a supporter of the Association. Just the following month Major Ian Sinnott was lost in an aircraft accident. Nino had served on the management committee until shortly before the accident and his loss was keenly felt.

ADVOCACY AND WELFARE

11. Again this year I draw the Association's attention to the work done by our welfare and pensions officer, Kevin Moss. He has continued to perform both functions in a manner that has brought great credit to himself and to the Association, while at the same time providing a vital service to the serving and ex-service community.
12. At a recent management committee meeting Kevin advised that he would be reducing his pensions activities, seeing current repatriation cases to their conclusion, accepting only widow's claims tasks and ceasing representation before the AAT. He will, however, continue at the same level with his welfare duties on behalf of Association members.
13. The committee would welcome any member that wishes to become involved in the satisfying arena of advocacy for our aging and younger veterans and currently serving Army Aviators.

AVIATION SOLDIER OF THE YEAR

14. The 2017 Aviation Soldier of the Year award, sponsored by the Association, was awarded to Sergeant Ceara Tyrrell of the 5th Aviation Regiment. The unit Ground Crew Mission Support Sergeant, Ceara is a dedicated, hard-working and capable soldier whose commitment, professionalism and technical ability have significantly contributed to the Regiment's flying operations. Her leadership and mentoring of junior members of her team has greatly improved soldier retention and the training competence of the members of her trade. Her dedication and performance has earned her high regard from superiors and the respect of peers. She is a very worthy recipient of the Army Aviation Soldier of the Year.
15. For those who think Ceara's name is faintly familiar, I can remind you that she won third prize in the 2012 Fourays Photos competition run by the Association.

COAC – ARMY AVIATION STUDENT OF MERIT

16. The Association again presented an award to the student of merit at the Combat Officers Advanced Course run at Puckapunyal. The award is presented only if there are two or more Aviation officers on the course and is in the form of a book, suitably inscribed with the name of the award.
17. The student of merit at the first course in 2017 was Captain David Hanssens and at the second course was Captain Thomas Burr.

UP COMING MILESTONES

18. The 1st of July 2018 will mark 50 years since the formation of the Australian Army Aviation Association. This significant occasion will be commemorated and celebrated in a number of ways.
19. The Army Aviation Association contingent will be among the lead contingents heading the 2018 Anzac Day march in Brisbane. All serving and returned veterans are encouraged to attend to ensure the contingent size is worthy of the occasion.
20. On 29-30 June 2018, the Association will host a gathering on the Sunshine Coast to celebrate the anniversary. The format will be similar to the gathering at the Gold Coast in 2010 for the 50th anniversary of 16 Army Light Aircraft Squadron. An informal cocktail party will get the ball rolling on the Friday evening (29th) to be followed by a coat and tie dinner on the Saturday evening. It is planned to launch the first volume of the History of Australian Army Aviation at the cocktail party.
21. The formal military celebrations will be delayed until October 2018 due to the extensive exercise period around the June-July period. The Association will keep members informed of the format and activities of the military celebrations
